Taylor's students get some career tips

THE Taylor's University Career and Employment Fair 2011 recently saw more than 60 companies converging at Taylor's Lakeside Campus, to offer students an opportunity to explore internship and employment opportunities.

The Taylor's Alumni Relations Office added further excitement to the event by organising Taylor's alumni mentoring network, which provided students with an opportunity to mingle and network with their predecessors.

The event was also open to Taylor's graduates who wanted to explore the local job market and establish links with industry heavyweights.

Phuoc Bao Tri, Nguyen, student of Taylor's Law School said: "Taylor's alumni mentoring network was a great way for students to get a little taste of the real world. It gave me a further understanding on my potential job in the market and available opportunities. were invited to attend the alumni mentoring network event. With each mentor assigned to about six to 10 students, the students were able to open up and share their concerns and doubts with their mentor in a relaxed and informal setting.

The visitors also attended a talk by Esther Tan, winner of FHM Girl Next

Door Contest 2011, who is a successful freelance model as well as a business development manager at Havells Sylvania. Entitled, "Don't leave your dreams to chance" she talked to the students about how it was possible to have a successful career while still pursuing your passion or dream.

According to Melissa Tan, a mentor who is currently a consultant with the Talent & Rewards segment of Towers Watson in Malaysia, "Such events are important because it gives students an insight on what to expect in the corporate world. The questions that were posed by the students were very similar to ones I had when I was in their shoes. For example, interview tips, what motivates me and what a day in my life at work is like."

Taylor's University deputy vice-chancellor Pradeep Nair said: "The alumni mentoring network is a twist to the run-of-the-mil career fairs and talks, which are very common.

"Several Taylor's alumni volunteered to share their invaluable work experience with our current students, in a very informal and friendly setting so that students could be better prepared for the 'real world' once they graduate.

students to network with potential employers, find out how to secure jobs and learn more about their future careers.
